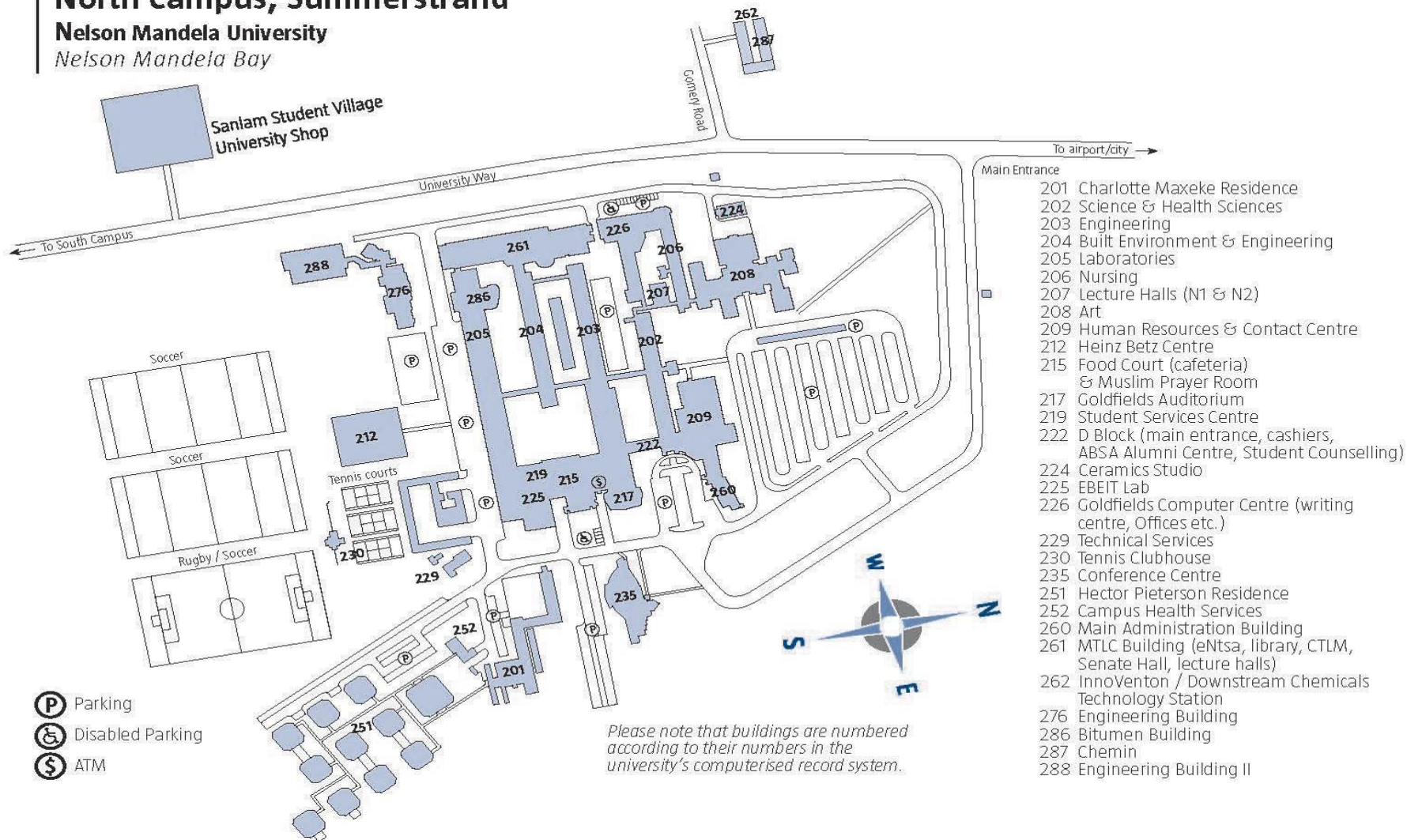

North Campus, Summerstrand

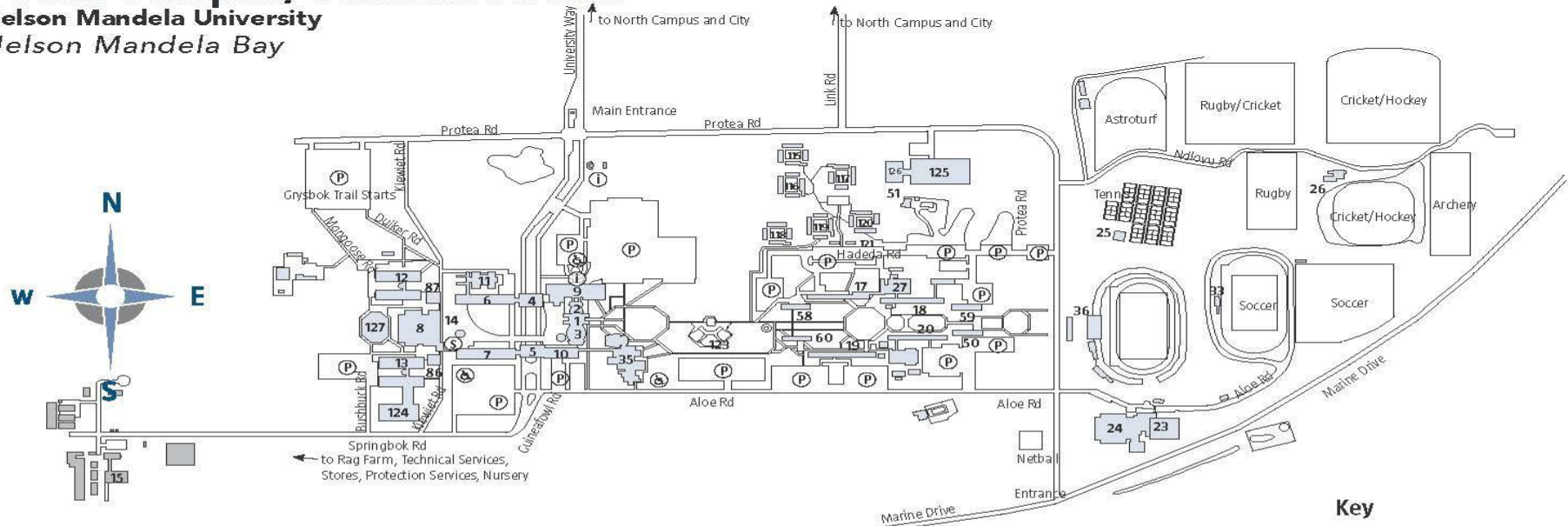
